

- 5. The left half of the moon is lit while the right half is dark.










- **3.** Tin-plated lanterns are popular in North Africa and the Middle East.
- 7. The standard greeting during Ramadan, it translates to "generous Ramadan" in Arabic.
- **9.** The 9th month of the Islamic calendar.
- **11.** The place of worship for Muslims. The Arabic term is masjid.
- **14.** A celebration popular in South Asian communities. It is a festival the night before Eid. It means "night of the moon" in several South Asian languages.
- **16.** The term for when Muslims do not drink or eat from dawn to dusk.

- **18.** The mandatory charity during Ramadan. All Muslims, if they are financially able, are asked to donate 10% of their income to charity.
- **19.** The pre-dawn meal eaten before fasting.

- 1. The special nightly prayer performed at mosques during Ramadan.
- **2.** A person that practices the religion of Islam.
- **4.** On the first night of Ramadan, Muslims look for the Ramadan Moon, the first sliver of waxing crescent, in the sky.

- **5.** It is customary to give money and gifts to children on Eid day. The envelopes that hold the cash are affectionately called this.
- **6.** A special plant-based paste that can be used to temporarily dye skin and hair a reddish-orange color.
